C&B MFH can also be used for the 3D printing of very tough veneers that are extremely accurate and have a very fine surface finish as well as denture try-ins. The balance between inorganic fillers and the resin give the material its high strength and wear resistance.

The material is easy to finish and polish, and can be stained with all types of composite staining kits to blend perfectly with the existing teeth for a natural look.

Directions for Use

1. This product is light sensitive; exposure to daylight, UV light or artificial lighting should be kept to a minimum during storage and handling
2. Shake or stir material well before use due to the possibility that the colorants may separate or precipitate over long storage periods
3. For best 3D printing: Mix the 3D resin before each print. Do not leave resin in printer when not in use. Filter the resin after each 3D print before reuse
4. Excess material can be easily wiped away with non-polar solvents.

Storage

Store product in a cool, dry location, in unopened containers at a temperature between 8°C and 28°C unless otherwise labeled. To prevent contamination of unused product, do not return any material to its original container.
